



FY 2016-2017 FEATURED RDN/NDTR Program Guidelines and Criteria

Overview:

The member program, **Featured RDN/NDTR**, is a California Academy Communication Council activity directed at promoting members that have demonstrated career, academic, and professional excellence in the field of dietetics. One RDN/NDTR per quarter will be announced and featured on the CA Academy's websites: www.dietitian.org and www.myCAND.org.

Guidelines for RND/NDTR Nominations:

1. Nomination(s) must be made by an active (current) member of the Academy of Nutrition & Dietetics (AND) & California Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (CAND)
2. Nominee must be an active AND & CAND member
3. Recipient of the nomination must be an active AND & CAND member
4. Nominations should be submitted to communication@dietitian.org.

Recipients will have met three of the six criteria:

1. Worked as a RDN or NDTR for at least 5 years
2. Hold an advanced degree or certificate recognized by an accredited institution
3. Hold a management/senior position at current employment
4. Be an inspiring role model representative of the dietetic profession
5. Actively involved in local dietetic association or CAND
6. Volunteer experience with district or community nutrition

Program Recipient's Raffle Drawing:

At the CAND Annual Conference (CANDAC), all FY2016-2017 program recipients will be entered into a raffle drawing. One free registration to the CANDAC 2018 will be awarded to one recipient. The winner need not be present at the CANDAC to win. Awarded registrations can only be used by the winner and are non-transferrable to other conference attendees.
